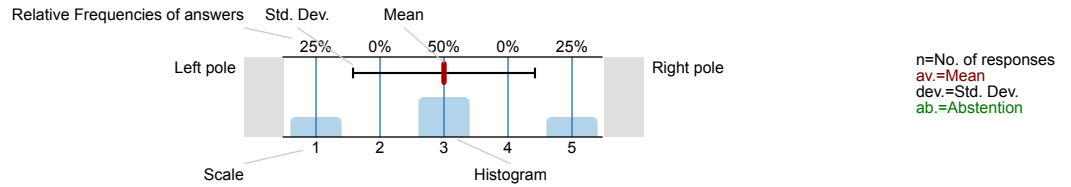

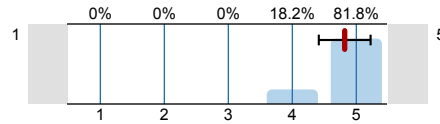

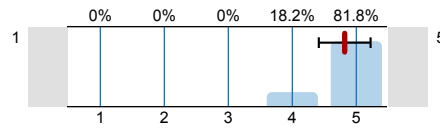

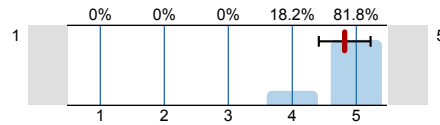

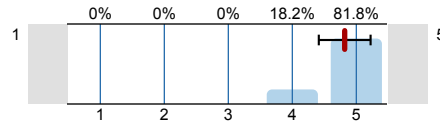

2.4) Quality of questions or problems raised by instructor



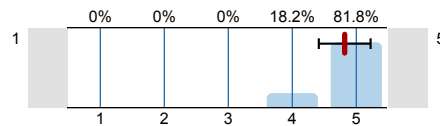

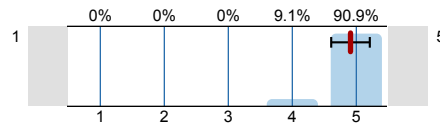

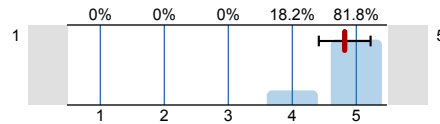

### 4.1) What are the major strengths and weaknesses of the instructor?

- Dr. Rasmussen finds the appropriate balance of support and rigor/challenge for curriculum and instruction. The course is enjoyable and worth my time. She respects our time as busy professionals.
